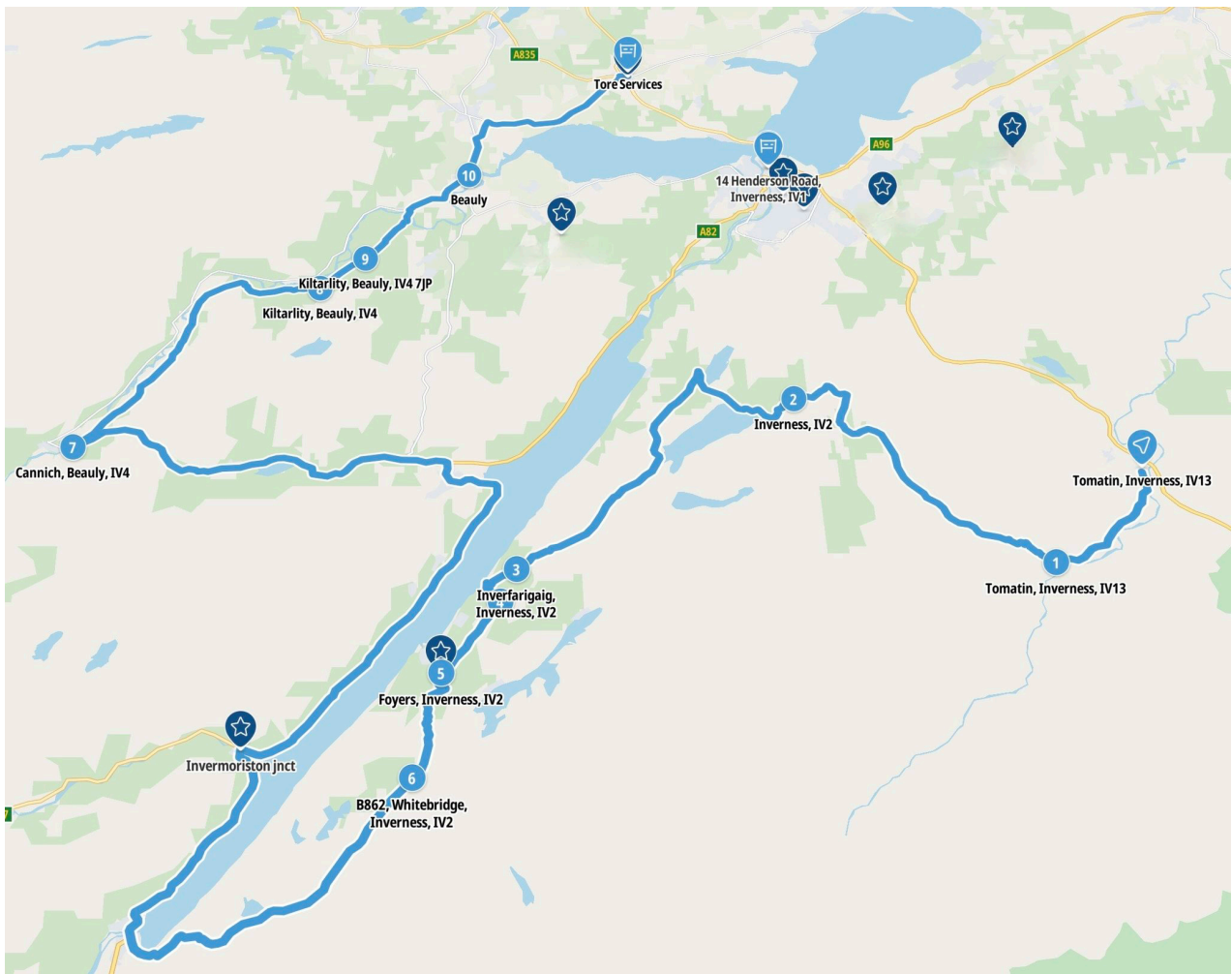

MOTO GUZZI - HIGHLANDS

Booking of accommodation will be to your own account. Visit planned in the next week or two and more detail will be forthcoming on the group website thereafter. Three routes already planned which will be shared with those attending nearer the time.

Note 2: Exploring the notion of holding a mg-h stall / stand at the extravaganza weekend. It is a huge do and there is camping available on site for bona fide exhibitors. Due to the nature of the event

restrictions may have to be imposed for the more modern Guzzis be exhibited although, as a group stand we can probably have examples of any. Preference will be for a broad spread of machines naturally. This is a great weekend with lots of other interesting stands and people.

Note 3: The Cullen skink run in '22 was a success and will be repeated in '23. Hopefully the Rockpool in Cullen will be the venue once more.
