Friday. 18th July 2025

Pitch up and head 5 mins into village for an evening meal and couple of pints in the Invercauld Mews.

Saturday. 19th July 2025

Take A93 towards Aberdeen then branch off to the south Deeside road at Dinnet crossing to the south bank of the River Dee then heading east on the A957 to arrive at Aberdeen.

Park machines at Guild Square Centre carpark [1], opposite the harbour. Grab some caffeine at Starbucks in the centre. Wander across the busy road to view the Tall Ships with a lunch in the Prince of Wales pub, 10 mins walk from bikes. Parking maybe an issue hence flexibility may be key. LARGE crowds are expected.

Back to the motorcycles and then head north to Newburgh [2] for afternoon tea using A956 then Ellon Road A92 then A90 and A975 to Newburgh and The Newburgh Inn [2]. After tea and cake, head back to the A90 then head north until just north east of Ellon taking the A948, passing a well known right wing brewery company. Then head to Auchnagatt on the B9030 tuntil New Deer where we swing east on the A950 towards Mintlaw to camp near Aden Country Park for the night.

Leave Mintlaw and head east to thrumble through Peterhead [4], the busy fishing town and site of a notorious prison, now closed and a museum. We then head nor'nor'west to Fraserburgh [5] [aka "The Broch"] then continue west along the Moray Firth coast to the picturesque villages of either Pennan [6] or Portsoy [7] or both - with a coffee stop somewhere along the route, with lunch to be taken at, or near, to Speybay [8].

After lunch head south to Craigellachie [9], Bridge of Avon [10] and Tomintoul [11]* to carry on over the Lecht back to Braemar.
